

# Layette Baby Quilt

## Finished Size 22x22

### Fabric Requirements

5 Fat Quarters: 1 light color for setting squares  
4 med/dark fabric for 4 patches, setting squares, and binding  
3/4 yard for backing and batting

1. From each med/dark fat quarters, cut (2) strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Randomly sew 2 strips together to create sets of 2 strips. Then cut sewn strips into 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" segments
2. Then sew sets of 2 to each other to create 4 patches. Make 16 4 patch blocks.
3. From setting square fabric, cut (9) 4 1/2" squares.
4. From 1 of four patch fabric, cut (2) 7" squares, and cut twice diagonally. This makes A triangle (see diagram). Cut another four patch fabric, cut (1) 7" square and cut twice diagonally to make (B) triangles.
5. To make corner squares use a third four patch fabric. Cut (2) 3 3/4" squares and cut once diagonally. (C)

Assemble, on the diagonal.

Sandwich, quilt, and bind.

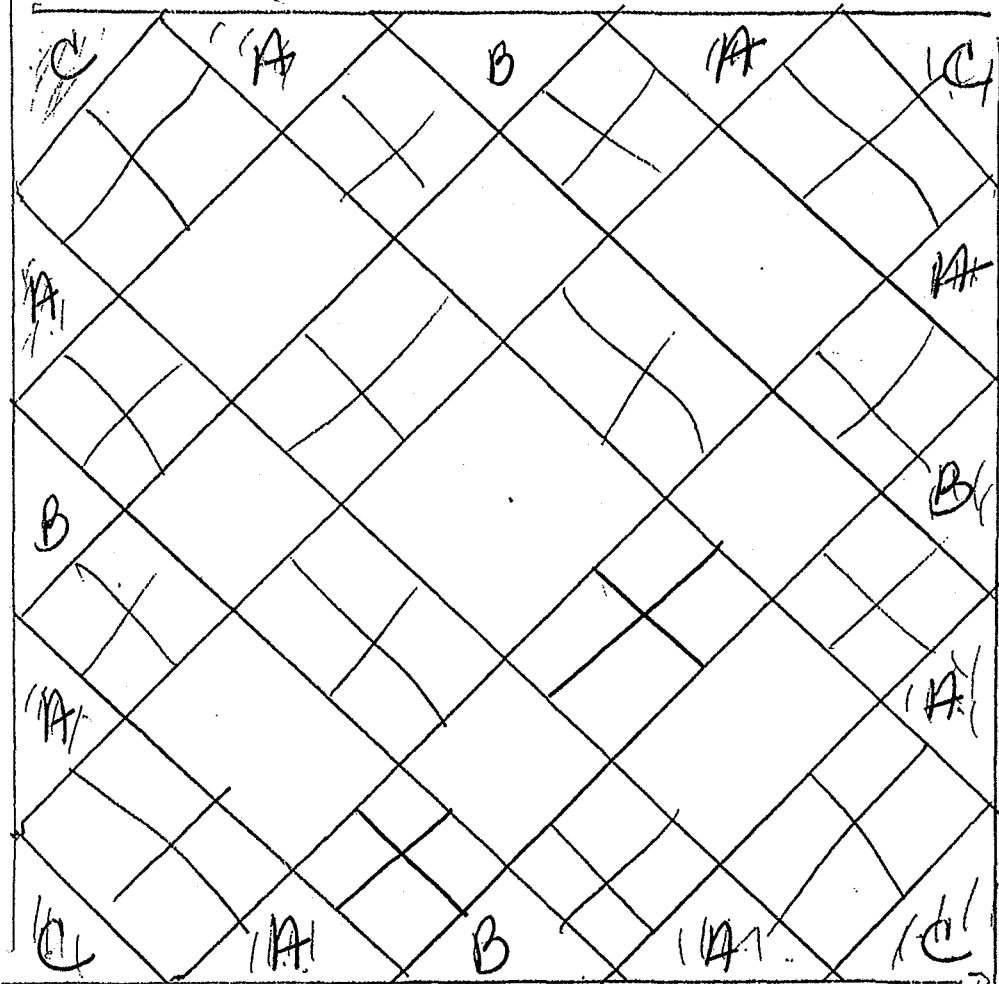
